The Marketing Intern will be responsible for individual projects and will also contribute to collaborative group projects.

### **Qualifications:**

The successful applicant must be a graduate of a post-secondary degree or diploma program from an accredited college or university. The position must be the applicant's first full-time employment in their field of study. This multifaceted position requires strong interpersonal, organizational and decision-making skills, with an ability to communicate with employees at all levels of the organization. Excellent computer skills and experience with Microsoft Office are also required.
